### Senior Citizen's Nutrition Program

Serving from 11:00 – 11:30 a.m., Mon – Fri

This program is designed to give Seniors 60+ the opportunity to have a nutritious lunch and to fellowship with others. Anyone aged 60+ can eat regularly at the program here in our church. You will be asked to fill out a form that they can keep on file.

If you would like to come and visit they would like for you to notify the church 1 day in advance although they usually have enough food to feed several drop in visitors. Several of our Fairview folks have come to eat and have found the food to be good and the staff to be friendly and accommodating. If you are not yet 60 but would like to visit, the nutrition program allows for our under 60 church folks to eat with the request that you pay \$6.00 for your meal. Anyone over 60 may eat and pay whatever you are able.

Pastor Hurley is planning to have tables of Euchre on Tuesdays after lunch, beginning at about 11:30. Anyone from the church is invited to play. It would be a good day to try out the lunch program. Just let the church office know that you will be eating lunch.

If you would like to begin a game day, a Bible study, a music time, or any other activity, let the church know when and what you would like to do and we will publicize it. We can make this program work with our own programs and connect with more of the guests in our building.
